- Smoke Detectors • Carbon Monoxide Detectors
- Door Locks • Window Locks/Dowels
- Peepholes

Provide the following documentation of your eligibility:

- Age or disability status (ID, SSI letter)
- Income (tax returns, pay stubs, Social Security award letter, etc).
- Residency at the property (current utility bill, landlord certification)
- If applicable, ownership of the property (property tax bill) (Written approval of the owner/manager is needed for renters.)
